1 INTRODUCTION AND APPOINTMENT

Iain McLennan and Boris van Delden, Insolvency Practitioners of Auckland, were appointed jointly and severally as liquidators of Brusan Designs Limited ("the company") on 10 December 2007.

Pursuant to Section 255(2)(d) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act"), the liquidators herewith report on the progress of the liquidation. This twenty second report should be read in conjunction with the liquidators' previous reports. This report is being sent to all shareholders and all creditors who have filed a claim in the liquidation.

A Statement of Realisations and Distributions is **attached**.

2 RESTRICTIONS

This report has been prepared in accordance with section 255(2)(d) of the Act. Whilst all care and attention has been taken in compiling this report, we do not accept any liability whatsoever to any party as a result of the circulation, publication, reproduction or use of this report.

We reserve the right (but are under no obligation) to review and, if we consider necessary, revise this report in respect of any information existing at the date of this report which becomes known to us after that date.

3 CONDUCT OF THE LIQUIDATION DURING THE PRECEDING SIX MONTHS

Asset Realisations

No assets have been identified or realised. The shareholders may have rights to the benefits from litigation in other liquidations.

4 INVESTIGATIONS

Given that there are no claims from any party, no investigations are necessary. The circumstances giving rise to the securitisation of assets though may be explored further depending on the outcome of litigation in the liquidation of Neil Timber Limited (in liquidation) ("Neil Timber").

At the time of this report, we have been advised that Mr John Henry Ede has been found guilty of 23 charges under the Insolvency Act, Crimes Act, and Companies Act, and has been sentenced to over 3 years in prison. Neil Timber has sought recovery from the beneficiaries of the fraud.

5 CREDITORS' CLAIMS

No secured, preferential or unsecured claims have been received in the liquidation.

6 FUNDS / LIKELY OUTCOME

Given that there are no claims from any party, no distributions are required except for any surplus funds that may become available for shareholders.

7 MATTERS DELAYING THE COMPLETION OF THE LIQUIDATION

The following matters are outstanding:

- Monitor litigation in other liquidations
- Completion of liquidation

8 ESTIMATED DATE OF COMPLETION

Based on the information contained in this report the liquidators presently propose to complete all outstanding matters with a view to retiring as liquidators within the next two months.
