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INTRODUCTION AND APPOINTMENT 1

> Peri Micaela Finnigan and Iain McLennan, Licensed Insolvency Practitioners, of Auckland, were appointed as joint and several liquidators of KP Mt Eden Limited (in Liquidation) ("the company") on 07 July 2021 by a special resolution of the shareholders of the company.

> Pursuant to section 257(1)(a)(i) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act") the liquidators herewith report to all creditors and shareholders that the liquidation of the company has been completed. This final report should be read in conjunction with the liquidators' previous reports.

2 RESTRICTIONS

Whilst all care and attention has been taken in compiling this report, we do not accept any liability whatsoever to any party as a result of the circulation, publication, reproduction or use of this report.

We reserve the right (but are under no obligation) to review and, if we consider necessary, revise this report in respect of any information existing at the date of this report which becomes known to us after that date.

REALISATION OF ASSETS 3

The attached summary provides the receipts and payments in respect of the liquidation since the prior report and since the commencement of the liquidation.

No assets were recovered during the liquidation. No assets were disclaimed. No assets were distributed without realisation.

The business ceased to trade around December 2018. The business assets were sold around this time and premises vacated. Most recoveries were applied to payment of the secured creditor, Silver Chef. Certain assets were left with the landlord as they were attached to the building.

The liquidators made no recoveries from the director/shareholder or creditors.

4.1 Secured Creditors

No claims were lodged by secured creditors. Silver Chef recovered their assets in the 2018 year following the cessation of trade.

4.2 Preferential Creditors

The Inland Revenue lodged a claim in respect of core GST and PAYE of \$45,521.

4.3 Unsecured Creditors

Two creditors lodged claims for \$140,045. No distribution was paid.

5 INVESTIGATIONS

The liquidators have completed their investigations into the books, records and affairs of the company. There were no matters to advance.

6 COMPLETION OF LIQUIDATION

The liquidation of the company is now complete. A statement of realisations and distributions is **attached**. All known assets have been disclaimed or realised, or distributed without realisation, and all proceeds of realisation have been distributed. The company is ready to be removed from the New Zealand Register ("the register").

7 REMOVAL OF COMPANY FROM THE REGISTER

The liquidators have given public notice pursuant to Section 320(4) of the Act of the intention to remove the company from the register.

The attention of all creditors or shareholders is drawn to Section 321 of the Act which provides that any person may send to the Registrar of Companies, not later than the date specified in the notice, an objection to the removal on any one or more of the following grounds:

- (a) That the company is still carrying on business or there is other reason for it to continue in existence; or
- (b) That the company is party to legal proceedings; or
- (c) That the company is in receivership, or liquidation, or both; or
- (d) That the person is a creditor, or a shareholder, or a person who has an undischarged claim against the company; or
- (e) That the person believes that there exists, and intends to pursue, a right of action on behalf of the company under Part 9 of the Act; or



(f) That, for any other reason, it would not be just and equitable to remove the company from the New Zealand register.

Note: Section 321(2) of the Act provides that a claim by a creditor or a shareholder or any other person against a company is not an "undischarged claim" if a receiver or liquidator has notified that person that the company has no surplus assets.

The date by which objections must be lodged with the Registrar is 31 October 2021.
