1 INTRODUCTION AND APPOINTMENT

MRH Construction Limited ("the company") was placed into liquidation by the High Court at Auckland pursuant to Section 241(2)(c) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act") on 8 April 2016 upon the application of Award Carpets Limited. Peri Micaela Finnigan and Boris van Delden, Insolvency Practitioners of Auckland, were appointed as joint and several liquidators of the company.

2 RESTRICTIONS

In preparing this report and its appendices we have relied upon information provided to us. We have not independently verified or audited that information. The company director has yet to provide any details regarding the failure of the company, the assets of the company, and the creditors.

Enquiries by the liquidators have identified that the company was involved in carrying out commercial fit out construction work in the Auckland region. Transactions on the company's bank account indicate that it probably ceased trading about the end of November 2015.

5 STATEMENT OF AFFAIRS

The Liquidators have been unable to prepare a Statement of affairs for the company as no information has been received from the director.

6 ASSETS AND PROPOSALS FOR CONDUCTING THE LIQUIDATION

As outlined in Section 4 above, the liquidators have not received any information from the director regarding the assets of the company.

We will complete a thorough review of the company's books, records and affairs that are available to:

- ensure that all assets are identified and have been properly accounted for,
- determine if there are any other avenues of recovery for creditors,
- determine if the company's officers have properly carried out their duties, and take appropriate steps where necessary.

If there are funds available for distribution to creditors we will verify creditors' claims and make a distribution. We will then complete the liquidation and request that the Registrar of Companies remove the company from the register.

7 LIABILITIES AND CREDITOR CLAIMS

7.1 Secured Creditors

At the date of liquidation there were no secured parties that had registered security interests against the company on the Personal Property Securities Register.



If any creditor believes that they have a Reservation of Title over goods and they have not perfected their interest, they should also contact us immediately.

7.2 Preferential Creditors

We have requested a creditor's claim form from the applicant creditor.

We are in the process of determining if there are any unpaid wages, holiday pay or redundancy pay owing to former employees.

The Inland Revenue Department has not yet provided us with a creditor's claim form but we understand that there is an amount due in respect of a default GST return of \$2,429.

7.3 Unsecured Creditors

No information has been received from the director regarding the creditors of the company. From our enquiries to date we have identified amounts due to unsecured creditors of approximately \$16,104. A schedule of known creditors and their addresses is provided at Appendix 1, as required by Section 255(2)(c) of the Act.

A notice to creditors to prove debts or claims is included at Appendix 3. Also enclosed is a creditor's claim form for completion and return to this office by Friday, 20 May 2016. Creditors that have not made a claim by the date on the notice may be excluded from any distribution made. If you believe that you are a secured creditor please contact us and the appropriate form will be sent to you.

8 CREDITORS' MEETING / LIQUIDATION COMMITTEE

A notice of the Liquidators' decision to dispense with the meeting of creditors is provided at Appendix 2.

Pursuant to Section 314 of the Companies Act 1993, creditors are advised that at any time in the course of the liquidation the Liquidator shall, at the request in writing of any creditor or shareholder, call a meeting for the purpose of appointing a liquidation committee.


