1 INTRODUCTION AND APPOINTMENT

North Shore Waterproofing Services Limited ("the company") was placed into liquidation by a special resolution of the shareholders pursuant to Section 241(2)(a) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act") on 24 July 2017 at 8:25 p.m. Boris van Delden and Iain McLennan, CAANZ Accredited Insolvency Practitioner, of Auckland, were appointed as joint and several liquidators of the company.

2 RESTRICTIONS

In preparing this report and its appendices, we have relied upon information provided to us. We have not independently verified or audited that information. The company has experienced trading difficulties since the passing of the founder of the company. The shareholders therefore resolved to place the company in liquidation.

5 STATEMENT OF AFFAIRS

A Statement of Affairs showing the company's estimated financial position as at the date of our appointment is provided at Appendix 1.

6 ASSETS AND PROPOSALS FOR CONDUCTING THE LIQUIDATION

We will realise all available assets.

The family of the deceased director have evaluated the possibility of buying the assets and name of the company from the liquidators, but have decided that this will not be possible as key management staff are unavailable to continue. To maintain the value of the company's customer database and goodwill, a company with a similar name was incorporated, and existing staff employed to satisfy ongoing demand for the company's services. This trading will now be wound down, and we will seek buyers for the company's name, customer database, and available work.

We will complete a thorough review of the company's books, records and affairs to:

- ensure that all assets have been properly accounted for,
- determine if there are any other avenues of recovery for creditors,
- determine if the company's officers have properly carried out their duties, and take appropriate steps where necessary.

If there are funds available for distribution to creditors, we will verify creditors' claims and make a distribution. We will then complete the liquidation and request that the Registrar of Companies remove the company from the register.

7 LIABILITIES AND CREDITOR CLAIMS

A schedule of known creditors and their addresses is provided at Appendix 2, as required by Section 255(2)(c) of the Act.



A notice to creditors to prove debts or claims is provided at Appendix 4. Also provided is a creditor's claim form at Appendix 5 for completion and return to this office by Friday, 8 September 2017. Creditors that have not made a claim by the date on the notice may be excluded from any distribution made. If you believe that you are a secured creditor, please contact us and the appropriate form will be sent to you.

7.1 Secured Creditors

As at the date of liquidation six secured parties had registered security interests against the company on the Personal Property Securities Register. Most of these securities were over goods supplied. As the company used goods supplied immediately on delivery and on site, the it had no inventory on hand at the date of liquidation.

Personal Property Securities Act / Reservation of Title

If any creditor believes that they hold a Purchase Money Security Interest entitling them to any goods or proceeds from realisation of goods, they should contact us immediately.

If any creditor believes that they have a Reservation of Title over goods and they have not perfected their interest, they should also contact us immediately.

7.2 Preferential Creditors

We estimate that there is approximately \$10,403.00 owing to former employees for holiday pay.

The Inland Revenue Department has not yet provided us with a creditor's claim form but we understand that there are amounts due in respect of GST, PAYE and other payroll deductions.

7.3 Unsecured Creditors

From our review of the company's accounting records and other information we estimate that the amount due to unsecured creditors is approximately \$ 37,761.00.

8 CREDITORS' MEETING / LIQUIDATION COMMITTEE

A notice of the Liquidators' decision to dispense with the meeting of creditors is provided at Appendix 3.

Any creditor or shareholder may at any time in the course of the liquidation request that the liquidators call a meeting pursuant to Section 314 of the Companies Act 1993, for the purpose of appointing a liquidation committee. Any request for a meeting must be submitted to the liquidators in writing.

for liquidators to act in reliance on information that is not provided in writing.
