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1 INTRODUCTION AND APPOINTMENT

Opua Coastal Preservation Incorporated (In Liquidation) (**society**) was placed into liquidation by the High Court at Whangarei pursuant to section 26 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 and section 241(2)(c) of the Companies Act 1993 on 12 April 2021 at 10:06 a.m. on the application of Douglas Craig Schmuck. Keaton Alexander Pronk (Licence No: IP107) and Iain McLennan (Licence No: IP82), Licensed Insolvency Practitioners, of Auckland, were appointed joint and several liquidators of the society.

Pursuant to section 257(1)(a)(i) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act") the liquidators herewith report to all creditors and shareholders that the liquidation of the society has been completed. This final report should be read in conjunction with the liquidators' previous reports.

2 **RESTRICTIONS**

Whilst all care and attention has been taken in compiling this report, we do not accept any liability whatsoever to any party as a result of the circulation, publication, reproduction or use of this report.

We reserve the right (but are under no obligation) to review and, if we consider necessary, revise this report in respect of any information existing at the date of this report which becomes known to us after that date.

3 REALISATION OF ASSETS

The only asset of the Society at the date of appointment was funds held in the Society's bank accounts. The amount of \$638 was received on closure of the accounts. No further assets have been recovered.

4 CREDITORS

5 INVESTIGATIONS

The liquidators have completed their investigations into the books, records and affairs of the Society. No further matters came to our attention that would result in a benefit to creditors.

6 COMPLETION OF LIQUIDATION

The liquidation of the Society is now complete. A statement of realisations and distributions is **attached**. All known assets have been disclaimed or realised, or distributed without realisation, and all proceeds of realisation have been distributed. The Society is ready to be removed from the New Zealand Register ("the register").

7 REMOVAL OF SOCIETY FROM THE REGISTER

The liquidators have given public notice pursuant to Section 320(4) of the Act of the intention to remove the society from the register.

The attention of all creditors or shareholders is drawn to Section 321 of the Act which provides that any person may send to the Registrar of Incorporated Societies, not later than the date specified in the notice, an objection to the removal on any one or more of the following grounds:

- (a) That the society is still carrying on business or there is other reason for it to continue in existence; or
- (b) That the society is party to legal proceedings; or
- (c) That the society is in receivership, or liquidation, or both; or
- (d) That the person is a creditor, or a shareholder, or a person who has an undischarged claim against the society; or
- (e) That the person believes that there exists, and intends to pursue, a right of action on behalf of the society under Part 9 of the Act; or
- (f) That, for any other reason, it would not be just and equitable to remove the society from the New Zealand register.

Note: Section 321(2) of the Act provides that a claim by a creditor or a member or any other person against a society is not an "undischarged claim" if a receiver or liquidator has notified that person that the society has no surplus assets.

The date by which objections must be lodged with the Registrar is 30 June 2022.
