Outsmart Nominee Limited ("the company") was placed into liquidation by a special resolution of the sole shareholder pursuant to Section 241(2)(a) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act") on 23 April 2018 at 4:00 p.m. Boris van Delden and Peri Micaela Finnigan, CAANZ Accredited Insolvency Practitioner, of Auckland, were appointed as joint and several liquidators of the company.

#### 6 ASSETS AND PROPOSALS FOR CONDUCTING THE LIQUIDATION

We will realise all available assets.

We will complete a thorough review of the company's books, records and affairs to:

- ensure that all assets have been properly accounted for,
- determine if there are any other avenues of recovery for creditors,
- determine if the company's officers have properly carried out their duties and take appropriate steps where necessary.

If there are funds available for distribution to creditors, we will verify creditors' claims and make a distribution. We will then complete the liquidation and request that the Registrar of Companies remove the company from the register.



#### 7 LIABILITIES AND CREDITOR CLAIMS

A schedule of known creditors and their addresses is provided at Appendix 1, as required by Section 255(2)(c) of the Act.

A notice to creditors to prove debts or claims is provided at Appendix 3. Also provided is a creditor's claim form at Appendix 4 for completion and return to this office by Friday, 15 June 2018. Creditors that have not made a claim by the date on the notice may be excluded from any distribution made. If you believe that you are a secured creditor, please contact us and the appropriate form will be sent to you.

#### 7.1 Secured Creditors

As at the date of liquidation there are no secured parties that have registered security interests against the company on the Personal Property Securities Register.

Personal Property Securities Act / Reservation of Title
