#### Liquidators' First Report

#### 1 INTRODUCTION AND APPOINTMENT

Southern Hemisphere Land and Property Investments Limited ("the company") was placed into liquidation by the High Court at Auckland pursuant to Section 241(2)(c) of the Companies Act 1993 ("the Act") on 17 December 2014 upon the application of Ascot Auckland Limited. Boris van Delden and Peri Micaela Finnigan, Insolvency Practitioners of Auckland, were appointed as joint and several liquidators of the company.

#### 2 RESTRICTIONS

In preparing this report and its appendices we have relied upon information provided to us. We have not independently verified or audited that information. Whilst all care and attention has been taken in compiling this report, we do not accept any liability whatsoever to any party as a result of the circulation, publication, reproduction or use of this report.

The company was unable to repay the secured debts in full.

#### 5 ASSETS AND PROPOSALS FOR CONDUCTING THE LIQUIDATION

The company asset consists of a property at 12b Waiatarua Road, Remuera, Auckland. The property was sold via auction prior to liquidation for \$1.5 million. The sale was unconditional as at the date of liquidation and was due to settle on 18 December 2014.

We will complete a thorough review of the company's books, records and affairs to:

- ensure that all assets have been properly accounted for,
- · determine if there are any other avenues of recovery for creditors,
- determine if the company's officers have properly carried out their duties, and take appropriate steps where necessary.

If there are funds available for distribution to creditors we will verify creditors' claims and make a distribution. We will then complete the liquidation and request that the Registrar of Companies remove the company from the register.

#### **6 LIABILITIES AND CREDITOR CLAIMS**

#### 6.1 Secured Creditors

As at the date of liquidation there were six registered security interests against the company on the Personal Property Securities Register.

- Commercial Factors Limited
- Finance and Investment Limited
- FM Custodians Limited
- Land House Limited
- Trade Indemnity + Surety Limited (2 x Securities)

We are aware there are competing secured claims and disputes over the priority of their mortgage(s). We are assessing secured claims and will provide a supplementary report to creditors as soon as possible.

Personal Property Securities Act / Reservation of Title

Should any creditor believe that they are entitled to any goods, or proceeds from realisation of goods, due to holding a Purchase Money Security Interest, they should contact us immediately.

If any creditor believes that they have a Reservation of Title over goods and they have not perfected their interest, they should also contact us immediately.

#### 6.2 Preferential Creditors

The applicant creditor's claim amounts to \$8,822.

We are not aware of any unpaid wages, holiday pay or redundancy pay owing to former employees.

The Inland Revenue Department has not yet provided us with a creditor's claim form but we understand there may be amounts due in respect of GST, PAYE and other payroll deductions.

#### 6.3 Unsecured Creditors

A notice to creditors to prove debts or claims is included at Appendix 4. Also enclosed is a creditor's claim form for completion and return to this office by Friday, 27 February 2015. Creditors that have not made a claim by the date on the notice may be excluded from any distribution made. If you believe that you are a secured creditor please contact us and the appropriate form will be sent to you.

#### 7 CREDITORS' MEETING / LIQUIDATION COMMITTEE

A notice of the Liquidators' decision to dispense with the meeting of creditors is provided at Appendix 2.

Pursuant to Section 314 of the Companies Act 1993, creditors are advised that at any time in the course of the liquidation the Liquidator shall, at the request in writing of any creditor or shareholder, call a meeting for the purpose of appointing a liquidation committee.


